Phase 1 – The collection of case-study summaries outlining how innovations in science and technology have had an impact in the South. Replies will be screened and, by **30 June 2010** approximately 15 candidates will be invited to prepare full-length reports (to be submitted by **31 July 2010**) detailing their successful experience (a template will be provided).

Phase 2 - Successful candidates will also be asked to share their experiences in a workshop to be held in Malaysia on **6-7 September 2010**. During the workshop, an expert committee will evaluate all presentations and select the best three for monetary awards of US\$5,000, US\$3,000 and US\$2,000 for first, second and third places, respectively.

Phase 3 - A book containing edited versions of the case studies will be prepared by ISTIC and TWAS for distribution throughout the South and made available freely on-line.
